Farmer Ken Vogel Has Clear Fundraising Lead Over 12th Assembly District Opponents

Linden, CA – Conservative farmer and former San Joaquin County Supervisor Ken Vogel leads the 12th Assembly District candidate field in fundraising as officially reported in 2015 end-of-year financial documents. Vogel also holds a more than 2-to-1 available cash advantage over his closest opponent with \$133,248 going forward.
