Republican Chris Lancaster Announces His Candidacy For The 59th Assembly District *Endorsed by Local Conservative Icon and Retired State Senator Richard Mountjoy*

Republican Business Leader Chris Lancaster today announced his candidacy for the 59th State Assembly District (Los Angeles and San Bernardino counties) which is open due to the retirement of Assemblyman Anthony Adams.
