Michelle Steel Endorses Allan Mansoor
Highest ranking Korean elected official in the nation

Costa Mesa, California – Michelle Steel, a member of the California Board of Equalization, the highest ranking Korean elected official, and the highest ranking woman in California, has endorsed Costa Mesa Mayor Allan Mansoor for the State Assembly seat of Van Tran, who is running for United States Congress.
