

Area Senators Endorse Allan Mansoor
“A partner in the fight to reform Sacramento”

Costa Mesa, California – Orange County State Senators Tom Harman and Mark Wyland, both committed reformers in Sacramento, have endorsed Mayor Allan Mansoor for State Assembly.
