### **Tribal Alliance Endorses Don Kurth!**

The Tribal Alliance of Sovereign Indian Nations (TASIN) has endorsed Republican Rancho Cucamonga Mayor Don Kurth for State Assembly in the 63<sup>rd</sup> District.

TASIN is an intergovernmental association of 11 federally recognized tribes in Southern California, including: the Agua Caliente Band of Cahuilla Indians; the Augustine Band of Mission Indians; the Cahuilla Band of Indians; the Morongo Band of Mission Indians; the Pechanga Band of Luiseno Indians; the Ramona Band of Cahuilla Indians; the San Manuel Band of Mission Indians; the Santa Rosa Band of Mission Indians; the Santa Ynez Band of Chumash Indians and the Soboba Band of Luiseno Indians.

### **Successful Fundraisers Bring In \$70,000**

The Don Kurth for Assembly campaign held three successful fundraisers last week. On Friday, May 14, Dr. Clint Adams, Dean of the Western University School of Health Sciences, hosted a major local fundraising event at his beautiful home in Haven View Estates that brought in more than \$40,000 for Don's campaign. **Senator Bob Dutton was in attendance.**
